SnapShot of Services

Adjustment to Vision Loss is the core of our work—we had nearly **100 new referrals** for those dealing with low vision.

Over 170 referrals were made to blind and visually impaired individuals **to community agencies** that could be of service to them.

Just over **730 visits were made to the homes of clients**, providing **1336 hours of in home support to nearly 100 blind and visually impaired clients** in need of assistance.

Eye Learn


We created both social and educational opportunities for our Young Adult Clients—ages 19-45 offering three different programs in 2018:

Young Adult Program

- We enjoyed a Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Railriders Game in May
- Held a Happy Hour at River Grille in October to learn about different Transportation options
 - Played Holiday Trivia in December at the Woodlands Resort

The **Eye Learn** program launched in April 2018 and helped provide group and individual training in assistive technology, vision rehabilitation, basic orientation and mobility, and training on the use of low vision aides.

We were so proud to offer 43 Eye Learn programs with 35 clients participating!





2018

The InSight Kids Club of NEPA now has 57 active blind and visually impaired children who share in the following:

- **8 monthly programs** consisting of an adaptive game night, a trip to ride horse, holiday cookie baking, and much more!
- Camp Sight and Camp Sight Junior had nearly 20 children partake in 20 days of fun!
- **14 High School Students** participated in the nine month long Transition Assistance program!

Our newly revamped **Vision Resource Center** attracted the attention of 170 appointments/walk in visits.

These visits created 125 customers. resulting in over 340 low vision adaptive aid products sold!!

We screened over 5,080 children at over 130 different sites—resulting in 318 children being referred for a comprehensive eye exam.

Almost 200 adults were also screened at 17 different. locations!

Over 75 C. Well Bunny Eye Education programs **helped 2186 children** learn about eye health and safety.




