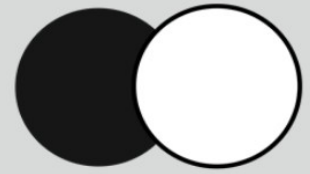

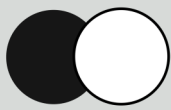

We wanted to give you a glimpse into the lives of the individuals you are supporting so generously with your gifts to Northeast Sight Services. This past year still brought many challenges as we attempted to navigate this new world but also so many incredible new successes that we are thrilled to be able to share with you—because without you none of this happens.

Barbara and Coleman Plecker became clients of Northeast Sight Services this past year after living with their combined vision loss in Florida just became too difficult to manage on their own. They moved to PA to be near their daughter and sought out our services.

Our Social Services Coordinator, Mary, worked together with them to develop a personalized service plan based on their needs. Mary visits them on a weekly basis to help with bill paying, audio books, iPad needs, etc...

Overall, Northeast Sight Services was able to provide over 500 visits to nearly 70 different clients like the Pleckers to help ensure they remain independent in their own homes.



Barbara and Coleman were also each referred for an appointment with our Low Vision Specialist, Dr. Anthony Silvetti, along with over 70 other individuals dealing with low vision this past year. Dr. Silvetti spent about two hours with each of them to discover what usable vision they have left and what items are available to benefit them best.

From that appointment, they were able to try a variety of adaptive aides and magnifiers in our Vision Resource Center, aimed at helping them navigate the day-to-day challenges posed by their eye conditions.

Northeast Sight Services was able to provide both the Pleckers, and over 150 more individuals, with items designed to help enrich their lives and support them in performing daily activities- products like liquid level indicators, handheld magnifiers, bump dots, monoculars, CCTVS and more. We have proudly helped put 347 low vision aids into the hands of those who needed them.

Our **Vision Rehabilitation Therapy (VRT)** program has been a tremendous success for so many of our clients. We are thrilled to have a variety of individuals partaking in these life changing programs. Clients have benefitted from simple bump dots being placed on their kitchen appliances so they can cook again, to more intensive assistive technology training on iPhones/iPads, to relearning how to safely navigate familiar spaces and locations.

The VRT training focuses on teaching those with vision loss adaptive ways to live independently within their home, school, or workplace. This year Northeast Sight Services was able to provide 100 hours of VRT to 38 individuals in need.

"I knew nothing about how to use an iPhone. And I had no idea what to do with it when it came," said Carl.

In August 2021, Northeast Sight Services' Vision Rehabilitation Therapist, Kristen Lilly, began to work with Carl to ensure that he could use his iPhone for all of his needs. Trainings occur weekly, as he continues to master all of the great features the phone has to offer. He can now call, text, check his email, listen to audio books and so much more with his phone.

"It's been really rewarding to see how far he's come and all the independence this phone training has given him," Kristen said.

Our Prevention of Blindness program was able to get back to a regular routine of screenings again in 2021. We had the privilege to screen nearly 5,000 children for undetected, yet treatable, vision issues at just over 100 different sites.

We were then able to refer nearly 300 of those children for a comprehensive eye exam. These screenings are so critical as 80% of what a child learns before the age of 12 is comprised of visual cues. Being able to provide this service is so important, as the preschool years are often the best time to discover issues for the maximum result in correction.

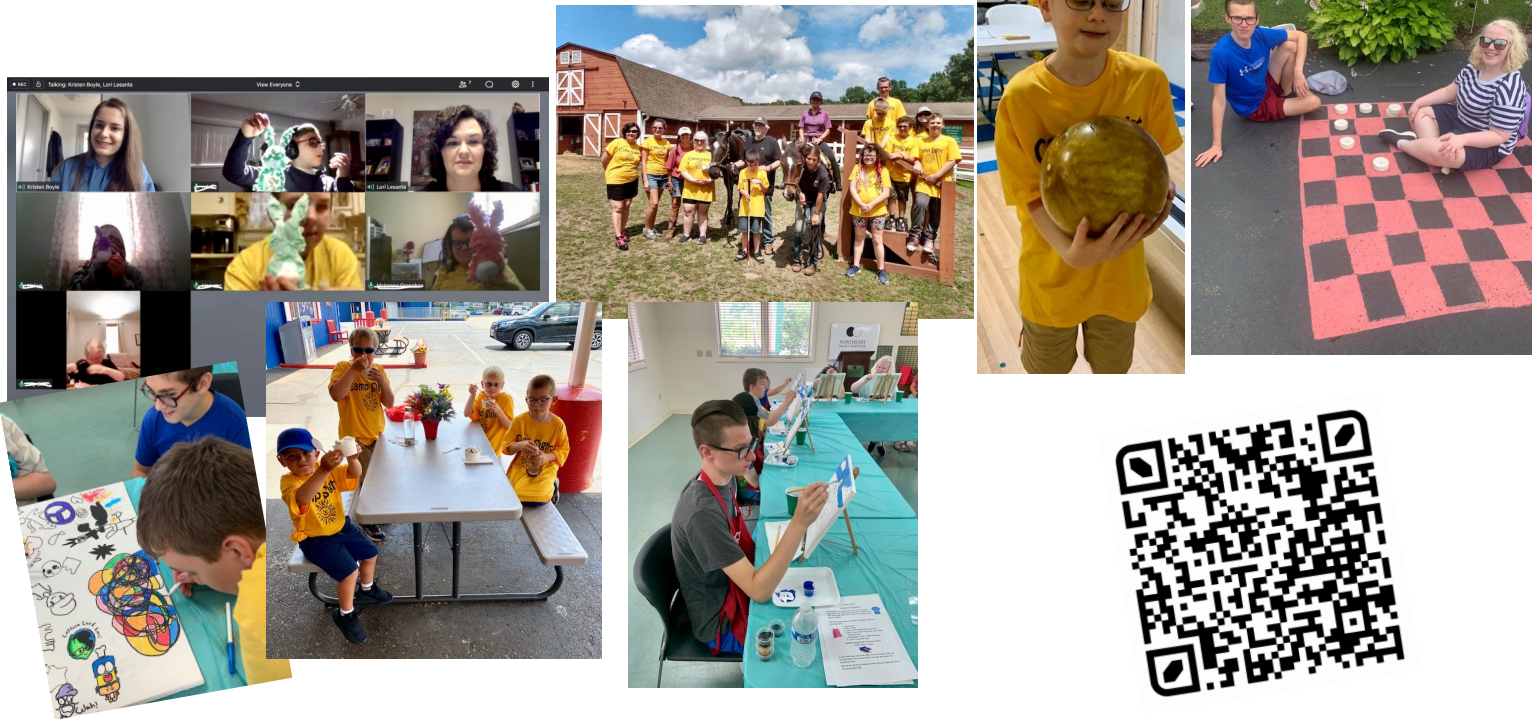

It is imperative for the participating children to learn the skills that they will need as they grow, but it has always been our main goal to ensure these wonderful kids are provided with a network of support from peers who are living with some of the same challenges.



We were thrilled to have 50 children participate in a variety of in-person and virtual programs this past year.

Camp Sight was back for 2021 with two weeks of fun for our kids, who enjoyed horseback riding, art classes, blueberry picking, scavenger hunts and more!



Robert has been participating in our program for the past three years—he's active at Camp Sight and at most of the monthly programs. His time with us and the relationships he has made are invaluable.

"All of this has given Robert a better perspective and helped him do more independently," said Robert's mother. "These programs have helped him communicate better and keep him active. As Robert continues with InSight, I've seen a greater self-esteem building inside him. But most importantly, he is developing more friendships, which he truly enjoys."

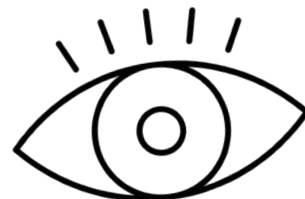

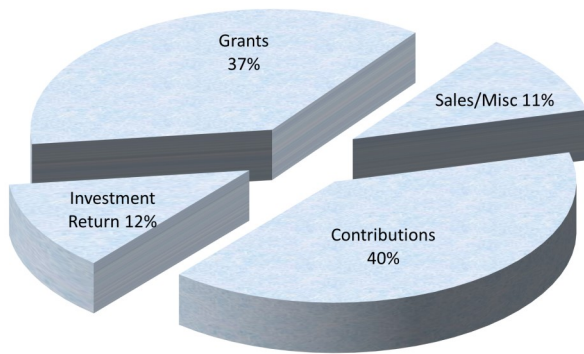

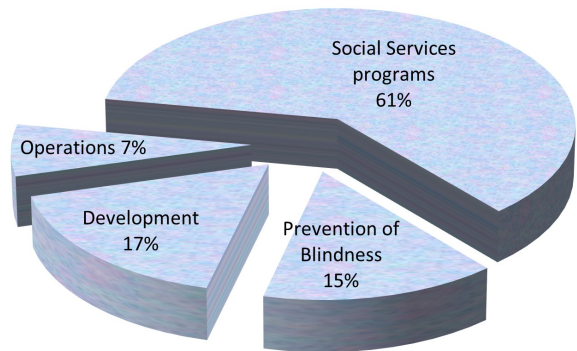
