IT ONLY TAKES THAT ONE STEP YOUR IMPACT IN ACTION

"It is crazy all the things (your other senses) start to notice, when it is now all you rely on," Amber said.

When Amber, 37, suddenly lost her vision last summer she thought she might have lost everything. She wasn't sure how she was going to take care of herself, let alone her recently adopted niece and nephew. She could no longer get around as she normally would and honestly, she felt like she could no longer do anything.

But not one to surrender and quit, Amber began the process of starting over – learning how to be a young, independent mother with low vision. Luckily she has an excellent support system – and they helped her get in touch with Northeast Sight Services. Then everything started to change.

Northeast Sight Services' Orientation & Mobility (O&M) training helps a person with a visual impairment know where he or she is in space and where he or she wants to go (orientation) and how to carry out a plan to get there (mobility).

But Orientation & Mobility is so much more than that. It is freedom, it is independence, it is providing someone with low vision a chance to live again by showing them a new way of life. It isn't always easy, but it's always worth it.

"I am getting my confidence back and regaining my independence," Amber noted. "I am learning to live again, which is the most valuable thing to me – I'm so grateful for the program."

Working with our O&M Specialist for an hour each week, Amber has learned so much. She's learning how to navigate, which requires the mastering of many skills and techniques, how to square up to face destinations, using the dial of clock as a navigation tool, finding and remembering landmarks, listening for cars to know when it is safe, recognizing different textures when walking, how to shield yourself safely when traveling to keep safe, how to navigate steps and elevators, plus so much more.

"I am never going to give up and so far that's working for me and I'm getting better and better. I feel better about myself – because someone is helping me live the way I want to live again. And I'm so grateful for that."

Northeast Sight Services proudly offered nearly 200 hours of Vision Rehabilitation Therapy (VRT) to blind and visually impaired clients.

These VRT skills teach and guide people as they learn new ways of accomplishing daily living skills after experiencing vision loss. Our goal is to encourage greater independence and an improved quality of life.

There is a wide range of assistive technology that our clients can benefit from learning how to use depending on their needs:

- Magnification
- Screen Reading Technology
- Various Different Applications
- Smart Phone/Tablet Accessibility

Our relatively new Assistive Technology program hit the ground running September 2022 and has been able to provide over 60 hours of assistive tech training to 11 different clients.


